Our entire production process takes place within a maximum radius of 25 km from our facilities. In doing so, we reduce the displacement of raw materials and minimise our carbon footprint. This strategy also fosters quality jobs, enriches the community and strengthens the local productive network.

Sustainable materials

We work with wood from responsibly managed forests in Europe, while increasing the consumption of raw materials produced in Zero Waste certified facilities.

We are increasing the presence of fabrics with EU Ecolabel certifications and made under the OEKO-TEX standard, as well as offering a wide range of 100% recycled textiles.

MINIM's minimalism is based on the elimination of the superfluous, highlighting only the essential.

This piece invites you to enjoy the simplicity and calm that come from a design stripped of ornaments, but full of purpose.



The MINIM collection consists of a series of chairs, stools and tables of different heights.

Extensive in finishes, both seats and backrests are available in oak, open pore lacquered or upholstered, and its metal structure can be lacquered in any colour, playing with contrasts or matching in search of a monochrome finish.

A small portion that, simple in appearance, is very complex in its preparation, where craftsmanship, technique and patience are the three constants of this product.







Fresh and simple ingredients can be used to create an exceptional dish.












BRUT by Flic



With the added utility of a USB connectivity piece and a pocket on any of its sides in order to charge in a practical and simple way all kind of devices.

The zips which enhance the silhouette of the piece while facilitating the upholstery phase are available in black, with the possibility of replacing them by a fluorescent option for the most bold and colourful projects.

Even the brutal can be warm and comfortable.

















Rather than focusing purely on the monumentality of brutalism, BRUT incorporates soft, rounded forms, creating a visual harmony that unites the structural with the organic.

OFFO by Arnau Reyna

A simple geometry that evolves to give rise to new pieces while maintaining the powerful play of balances between the circle and the rectangle.







The new divan is added to the three existing modules of the OFFO collection, expanding the combination options.

In common with the rest of the OFFO modules, this new piece can be upholstered in a wide range of fabrics, with a choice of textures that enhance the sensation of comfort and colours that add character.

The side tables are designed to interact with the modules, and can be placed between them, or separately, adding colour contrast or matching the upholstery, as they can be lacquered in any RAL or NCS reference.

As a new feature, all modules in the collection can be fitted with USB charging devices.
